

Graduate Research Assistant opportunity

We are seeking a graduate research assistant for the project *Understanding vulnerabilities of Indian female migrants during COVID-19*.

The position is for 40 hours over 10 weeks, flexible, with possible extension, to start in September 2021. Pay is \$24-26/hour depending on experience. Major tasks include virtual recruitment and interviewing of informants living in Canada as well as making summary/highlight notes following each interview and checking the Zoom generated interview transcript with audio recording.

Applicants should be masters or doctoral students. Experience using Zoom for interviews would be helpful. Knowledge of issues facing women of the Indian diaspora is a significant asset.

This is a joint project between Belinda Leach, University of Guelph and Urmi Nanda Biswas, Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda and is funded by the Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute.
